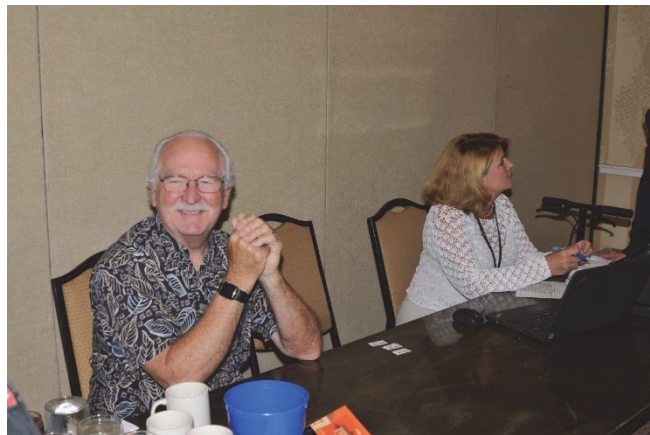
President Keith Funderburk presided over the meeting.



Adam Rozen conducted the invocation, led the club in the Pledge of Allegiance and Four Way Test and gave a Meet Your Rotarian talk.



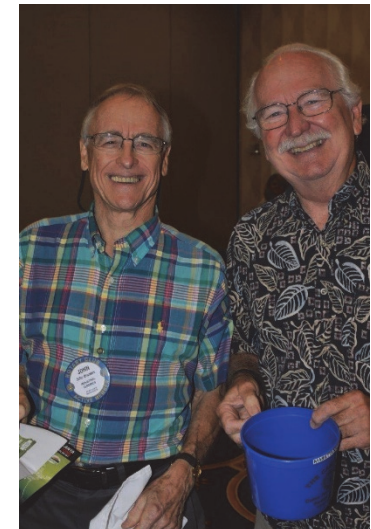
Amy Erskine won a Home Depot gift card in the Carithers Scholarship raffle.

PDG Leon Benefield introduced guests and visiting Rotarians, conducted the Carithers Scholarship raffle and gave a Meet Your Rotarian talk.



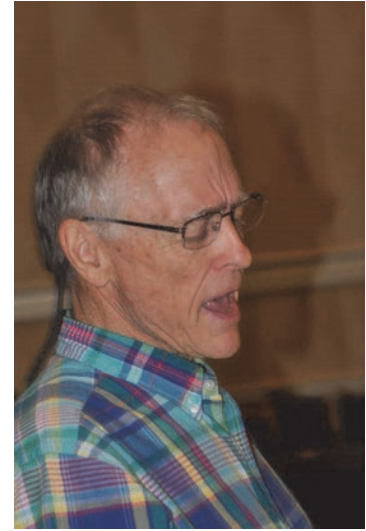
John Brookes won Atlanta Movie Tours tickets in the Carithers Scholarship raffle.

John Brookes gave sunshine for 55 years of marriage with his wife **Carol** and donated \$55 in honor of it to Cobb Diaper Day.



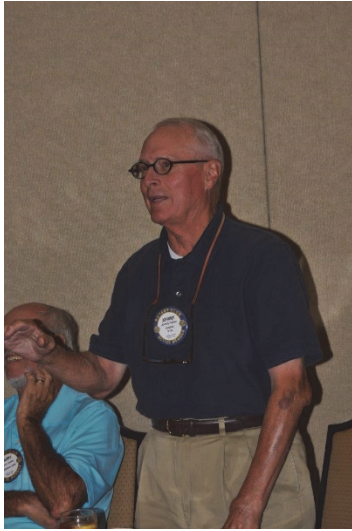
Past President Charles Lassiter gave sunshine for Wake Forest football being ranked and for successfully hosting a family reunion.



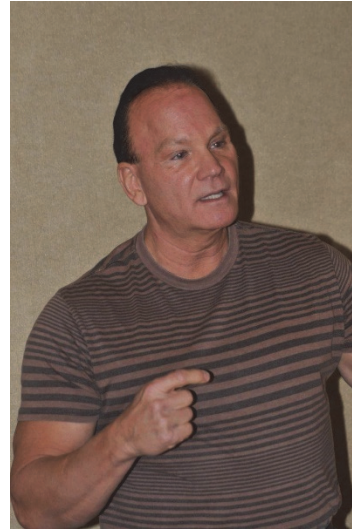
Past President K.C. Kadow gave sunshine for his daughter attending the University of the South in Sewanee, Tennessee.



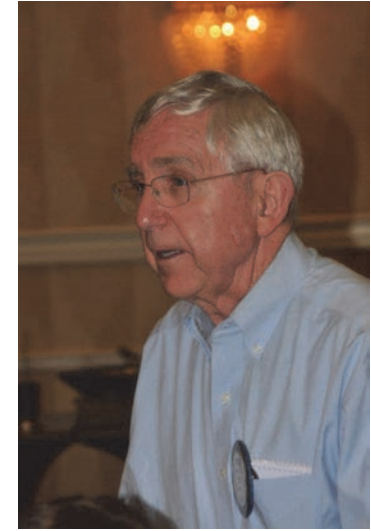
Gordy Nichols gave sunshine for a trip to Seattle to see some of his children and grandchildren.

Mark Bigelow discussed improvements the club is helping the CCYA with and asked for volunteers to help install vinyl flooring there.



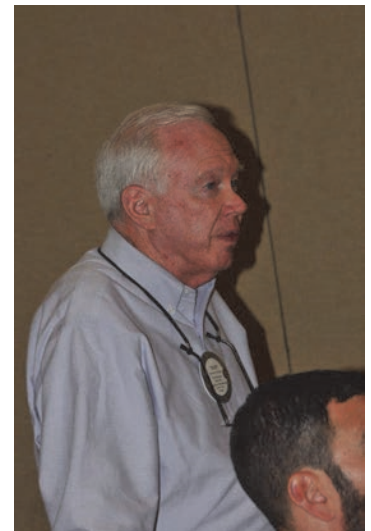
Past President John Elliott gave an update on the literacy service project taking place at the Emily Lembeck Center.

Past President Jim Boone asked for volunteers to help serve meals at the Men's Extension on October 9th.



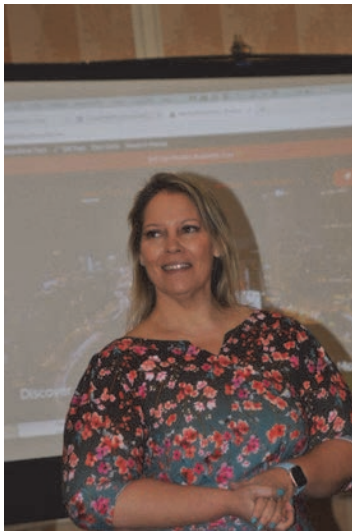
Past President Bob Harper spoke about separate seminars on Elder Issues and Mental Health.
